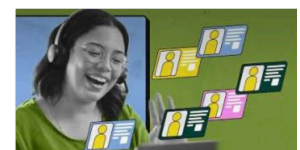

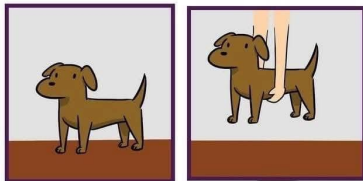
JOIN THE COMMITTEE
